**Directions to the Maine SYC Beach Day 08  
at Range Pond State Park in Poland Springs.  
*August 16<sup>th</sup> from 10am to 4pm***

**From P.L. - Range Pond State Park is about 33 miles south and should take you about 45-50 minutes.**

Turn Right out of Pilgrim Lodge Ln onto Neck Rd for 2 miles.

Slight Right turn onto Hallowell Rd - which bends hard to the left right after you turn onto it. - for 2 miles.

Turn right at the four way intersection onto Rts 9 and 126 - Gardiner Rd - for almost 11 miles.

Turn left at the four way intersection, onto Rt 9 - Middle Rd - in Sabbathus - for about 1.5 miles.

Turn Right onto I-95 South - for about 10 miles.

Take exit 75 at Auburn. – Follow directions below from Auburn.

**From North of Auburn:**

Take the Turnpike to Exit 75 in Auburn.

Turn Right onto Rt 100/202/4 - Washington St - apx 1 mile.

Turn Right onto Rt 122 – for about 0.8 of a mile.

Turn Left or stay on Rt 122 – Hotel Rd for about 3 miles.

Turn Right onto Empire Rd – for about 0.5 of a mile - Range Pond State Park is on the Left.

**From South of Gray:**

Take the Turnpike to Exit 63 in Gray.

Turn Left onto Rt 202 - for about 0.3 of a mile.

Turn Right onto Rt 26 A - for about 1.5 miles.

Turn Left onto Rt 26 – for apx 7-8 miles.

Turn Right onto Rt 122 – also called Spring Water Road. – for about 1.5 miles

Turn Left onto Empire Road – for about 1 mile – Range Pond State Park is on the Left.

**Other things to know about Beach Day 08:**

There is no food vending at Range Pond, so please be sure to pack a lunch and snacks. The EC will bring a cooler full of bottled water. There are several stores along the various routes, and many of them make sandwiches and other foods.

Gas is expensive so please try to car pool, and feel free to use the Maine SYC bulletin board to try and coordinate rides. That is just one of the many great things about our website. What is the website again ...
